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Schola Salernitanus

A medical school at Salerno, Napoli, Italy, chronologically the first and perhaps the most famous of such schools after the fall of the Roman Empire. Founded before the 10th century, it had, by the 12th century become a public University with an organised 'Collegium' of doctors who awarded degrees and diplomas. By the 15th century the right to confer medical licences had been transferred from the King to the Schola Salernitana. Of its publications, the two oldest surviving are *Practica* by Petrocillus (c. 1035), and *Passionaria* by Gariopontus (c. 1040). The writings of Trotula, the lady doctor, a descendant of the noble Ruggero family can be dated around 1059. There were actually many lady doctors in Salerno, highly respected, and able to prescribe cosmetic products as well as medicine. A 12th century illuminated manuscript, c.1140 by Matthaëus Platearius, entitled *Circa instans*, is one of the most important herbals of postclassical times (in the NYBG library). Towards the middle of the 13th century, the didactic poem called *Schola Salernitana, Flos Medicinae, Regimen Virile, Regimen Sanitatis* made its appearance. Neither the author, nor the era in which it was composed are known for certain. It appears to be the work of many, but no one in particular. Decline set in after the founding of a rival medical university at Naples, especially under the rule of the Aragon princes from 1436 until the first years of the 16th century. After the middle of the 18th century it existed more or less in name only, until it disappeared forever with a decree of 29 Nov 1811.
